Questions

Read 1 Corinthians 15:3-4, notice that Paul says "I passed on to you what was most important and what had also been passed on to me..." What does this statement mean to you when paired with the rest of verses 3 and 4?

For what reasons does Paul claim that the resurrection is the core of our faith? Why is this one thing more important than others things like: our understanding of the Bible, our regular attendance at church services, etc...?

What about Paul's own life does he speak about to show how much faith he has in the resurrection? (1 Corinthians 15:30-31) What do you think this says about how we should be living our lives today as followers of Christ?

When you consider all the things, we spend time arguing about with those in the world who are not believers, does the resurrection fall into our top 5? If not, why do you think that is?

Apply SOAP (Scripture, Observation, Application, Prayer) to:

Philippians 1:27 (NLT)

Above all, you must live as citizens of heaven, conducting yourselves in a manner worthy of the Good News about Christ. Then, whether I come and see you again or only hear about you, I will know that you are standing together with one spirit and one purpose, fighting together for the faith, which is the Good News.

Read the verses out loud together,
